

Mol an Oige Steiner NS Enrolment Policy

The Board of Management of Mol an Oige Steiner NS has set out this policy in accordance with The Education Act of 1998 and the Child Welfare Act. This policy is to assist parents in relation to enrolment matters.

The school is in receipt of grants from the Department of Education and Science, and operates under the regulations laid down by the Department. The school works within the framework of the revised curriculum as laid out in the Education Act of 1998.

The school is co- educational from junior infants to sixth class. It is central to the schools ethos that each child is provided with the best education possible in a caring atmosphere. The school respects that

- All children with disabilities are enrolled and provided relevant tuition.
- Children with different social backgrounds, race, religion, tradition and language are given equal opportunity in education.

The Board of Management makes the decision on a child's enrolment in accordance with the schools policy. The Board generally allows that children will be enrolled immediately. However this is dependent on there being sufficient space. It is the policy of Mol an Oige Steiner NS to enrol pupils on a first come first served basis.

Enrolment from another school:

The school does not accept new enrolments after September 30th of any school year, unless a child's family has just moved to the locality.

If a child has moved to the locality then the child is enrolled immediately. The child's previous school will be contacted and asked to forward all relevant information with regard to the child in our school. This information will be placed in the child's file. See attendance policy.
