Applications received after this date will be considered and processed as late applications in accordance with the school's Admission Policy.

All applicants to Junior Infants will be notified of an offer of a place or refusal of admission by:	21/03/24
Successful applicants to the Junior Infant Group must confirm their acceptance of an offer of admission by completing and returning the Acceptance Form on or before:	04/04/2024

Note: Failure to accept an offer of admission by the relevant deadline set out above may result in the offer being withdrawn.
